After being nominated for Premiership Rugby Breakthrough Player of the Season in 2024, Guy Pepper signed a three-year contract with Bath Rugby, joining the club ahead of the 2024/25 season.

Raised in Eggleston, Teesdale, Guy Pepper attended Barnard Castle School before joining Durham University and the Newcastle Falcons simultaneously in May 2021. He debuted for Newcastle in 2022, quickly making an impact by scoring three tries in his first seven appearances.

Internationally, he has represented England at U18 level, was named in the England U20 squad in 2023 and was called up to train with the senior England squad for the conclusion of their 2024 Six Nations campaign. Coming from a strong rugby family, with his father Martin a former Harlequins player, Guy balanced his rugby career with completing a degree in Sport and Exercise Science at Durham University.

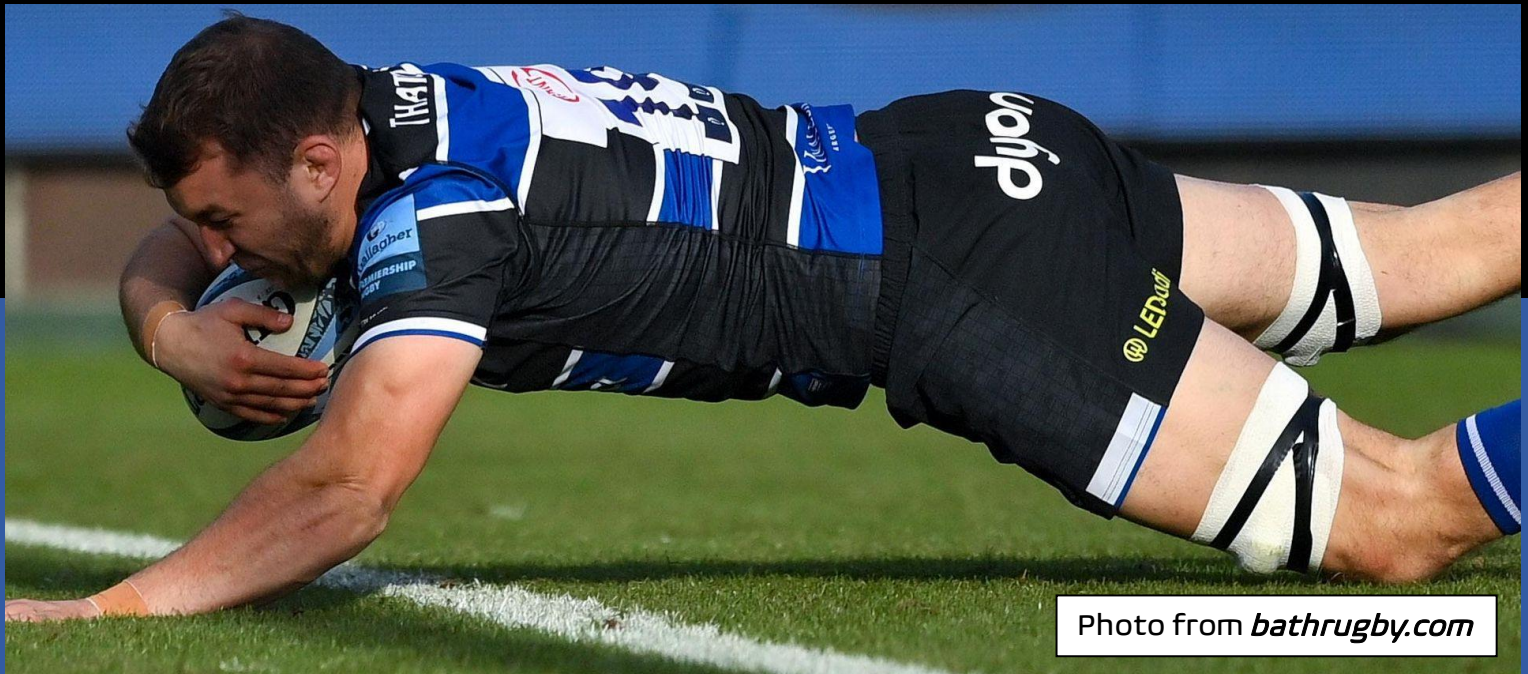

Kelvin Brunton:
BRSC Newsletter Obituary

BRSC was deeply saddened to learn of the passing of Kelvin Brunton on 20th August 2024, aged 75.

Kelvin was a staunch, life-long supporter of Bath Rugby and had been a member of the Bath Rugby Supporters' Club for many years, in fact, helping to establish its IT base in the 1990's and supporting his late wife, Penny, as Secretary of BRSC (1996-2006) and then Chair of BRSC (2006-2008), in its early days.

Kelvin was a "regular" at The Old Green Tree pub, in Green Street, Bath where he would meet with friends and fellow Bath Rugby supporters to discuss the prospects of the forthcoming match and often, after the game, to dissect the result.

Kelvin's "Celebration of Life" was held at Haycombe Cemetery & Crematorium on 13th September 2024 and afterwards at The Old Green Tree.

Kelvin leaves three sons Andrew, Michael & Guy and his beloved grandchildren.

The thoughts of the BRSC Committee, Members and fellow supporters are with Kelvin's family and friends at this sad time.
